Furthermore, some people said Inspirit is good alternative for Bryce. I have a plan to remove Inspirit, its top sheet from sponge. I'll use only its sponge, and for the top sheet I have a good one. We know Bryce for its speed and "bouncy-ness". I think that Dawei sponge is good one, but the top sheet isn't too spinny, so I replace the top sheet.
