

they are not even close. Tensors are very 1 dimension (a lot of speed, ok spin, terrible short game). Tenergy is one of the most dynamic rubber on the market, it has good speed, lots of spin (topsheet AND sponge), and an adequate short game. I had used a sheet for 5 months and it was in the same condition as the 1st month.

That's good to know. Tensors have been getting a lot of flack due to durability issues, but Andro touts the Roxon as being durable, and so far mine is still doing well (although I'm not playing as much as I was last year). I really think the Roxon has improved by leaps and bounds over previous generation tensors.
